## Private Hire

# Conditions of Hire

**A minimum of 24 hours notice is required or the full fee will be charged. For bookings over 4 hours a minimum of 7 days notice is required for a full refund. Less than 7 days notice will only receive a 50% refund.**

**Bookings often run back to back so please ensure you have allowed enough time to set up and pack away.**

## **Conditions of Hire**

- For health and safety reasons any person hiring the facilities outside of normal working hours must be accompanied.
- Approved hard hats must be worn at all times whilst mounted.
- The hirer is liable for all breakages/damages which must be reported to a member of Equine staff.
- Any person wishing to hire the facilities does so at their own risk.
- Shuttleworth Equine Unit takes no responsibility for any accident or injuries to horses, riders or accompanying persons. Please ensure you have adequate insurance cover.
- There is a strict NO SMOKING policy in and around the indoor arena.
- Dogs are not permitted in the schools and must be kept on leads in the car park.
- All equipment is hired on a self set up basis. Hirers are responsible for ensuring equipment is stored away neatly after use – failure to do so will render the hirer liable to additional charge.
- A full set of show jumps and a set of white dressage boards are available for use.

Instruction for riders of all levels.	1 hour	£40

A course of fences are built in the arena for you to set at the height you require.	1 hour	£25 per hour plus £5 for additional horses
Learn how to lunge or long rein safely or brush up on your existing skills. This course covers the theoretical aspects before moving on to look at use and fitting of equipment. Following demonstrations, there will be opportunities to practise and develop your lunging and long reining skills on our experienced horses.	3 hours	£30
Learn about the horse's lower leg anatomy. Students will be able to observe the bones, tendons and ligaments in the lower leg and explore their structure and function. This interactive approach ensures there is plenty of time to ask questions and gain a deeper understanding of horse anatomy.	3 hours	£30
This course provides an opportunity to develop skills and knowledge needed when preparing a horse for showing or competition. Learn about grooming, pulling, trimming and plaiting and how to achieve a professional result.	3 hours	£30
An introduction to massage techniques and the opportunity to practice them. This course begins by looking at the benefits of massage to the horse. It then provides an introduction to different massage strokes and their uses. Students will practise the application of the massage strokes leading to a full body massage.	3 hours	£30

## Centaur Biomechanics

Centaur biomechanics uses rider analysis to improve standards of riding at every level, from Riding Club to Grand Prix. It uses video analysis with the aim of the session being to improve the rider's position. Riders are recorded at walk, trot and canter and their positions are analysed and corrected. # Winter Show Jumping & Dressage League

## Winners

The winner of each championship will receive a championship rosette and sash and a voucher for £40 for Shuttleworth College which can be used against school hire or entry fees.

## Runners up

The reserve champion will receive a championship rosette and £20 voucher for Shuttleworth College.

## League Rules

- The champion and reserve champion must be in attendance at the final show to collect their prize. Non attendance will mean forfeiture of their prize and it will pass to the next competitor with most points.
- Points will be awarded relative to the placing, 1st place, 6 points; 2nd place, 5 points; 3rd place, 4 points; 4th place, 3 points; 5th place, 2 points; 6th place, 1 point.
- Points are awarded to horse and rider combination.
- In the event of a competitor competing in three classes at any one show then only the best two results will count towards the Winter League.
- The Judge's decision is final.
- Shuttleworth College does not accept any responsibility for loss, damage or injury to horse, rider, spectator or property.
- Hard hats must be worn at all times whilst mounted.
- Correct show attire must be worn.
- The organisers reserve the right to alter, modify, reduce, cancel or make any alterations to classes without notice.

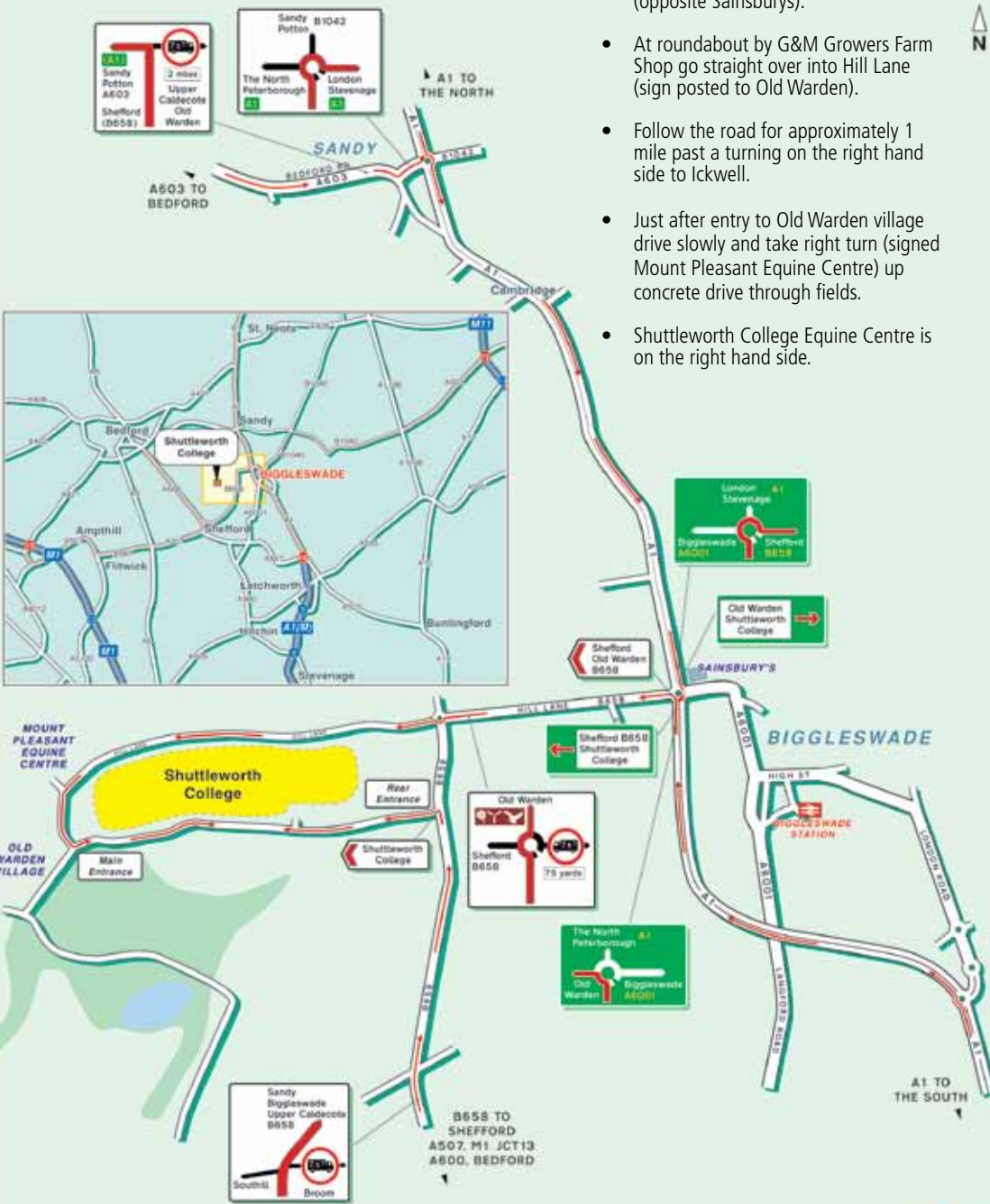
