WHERE CAN I GO FOR HELP COMPLETING THIS FORM?

HOW DO I KNOW WHAT PROOF OF INCOME TO PROVIDE?

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

Approximately 4 weeks after handing your form in you will receive a letter from us letting you know if you have been successful and what you have been awarded. If you are receiving a monthly or termly payment your attendance will be monitored electronically.

WHAT IF I DON'T AGREE WITH THE DECISION?

If you wish to appeal against a decision please put it in writing to the Director of Quality within 10 days of receiving your award letter. Appeals will be acknowledged within 3 working days of receipt and resolved within 21 working days

HOW WILL I BE AWARDED?

You will receive a discount towards an essential course cost (usually for a payment you have to make to the college, such as a trip), or a payment directly into your bank account (usually for an item you have to buy yourself, like a book).

I AM A RESIDENTIAL STUDENT CAN I APPLY FOR A BURSARY TO PAY MY FEES?

There are a small number of bursaries available to help pay towards the residential fees. Please contact us for an application form. These will be awarded to those students in the greatest need and will be awarded based on household income. If you are awarded a residential bursary you will be still expected to pay a contribution towards your accommodation fees.

I AM A FLORISTRY STUDENT, HOW WILL I RECEIVE MY COURSE MATERIALS?

You will be awarded an amount towards your course materials each month and this will be paid to the Floristry Department, you will then be able to purchase your course materials from your tutor.

You may be entitled to apply for a £1,200 bursary. Please provide a letter from your Social Worker confirming your circumstances, or proof of your income support.
